

Literacy

To inspire children with their writing we will be exploring a variety of traditional tales and fantasy stories such as 'The Gingerbread Man', 'The Gruffalo' and the 'Gruffalo's Child. We will be making woodland crowns and then writing to explain how we did this.

ICT

- Securing number facts, relationships and calculating

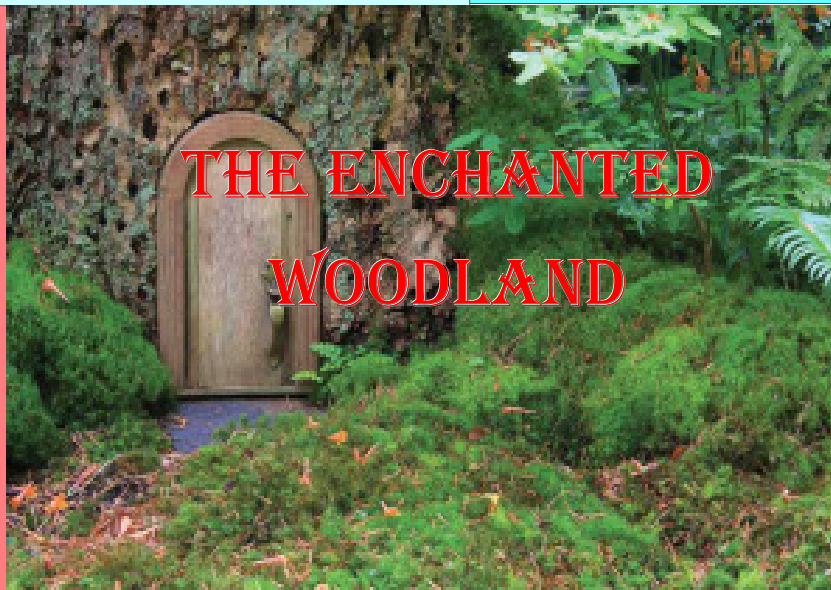
General

Science

During this topic children will be identifying and naming common flowers and trees found growing in the local environment. We will also be researching and finding out about a range of common animals from the local and wider environment. Children will be planting their own seeds and then watching them grow and naming the basic structural parts of common flowering plants.

RE

Our focus for this term is Christmas. We will be learning about the Christmas Story and the meaningful gifts linked to baby Jesus. The children will also take part in a Godly Play.

PSHE/SEAL

The focus this term will be on safety. The children will learn about road safety and how to stay safe when out and about in public places.

Art and Design Technology

The children will be exploring and then making their own wacky and wonderful tree boggart! Children will collect a variety of woodland nature to make their own woodland crowns. During the term, children will be drawing and then painting pictures of a variety of woodland creatures.
