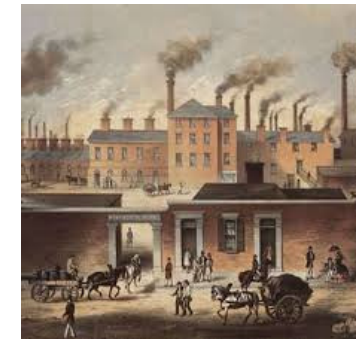


# Revolution



## Year 6 homework project options for term 1

Below are five options for homework projects for this term. Each project incorporates different skills and you should choose at least one of these to complete before the end of term. Each project has a number of house points attached to it; we have allocated the number of house points according to the level of difficulty/time needed for each project.

Although you may choose to complete more than one project we must stress that it is quality not quantity that counts; we would rather receive one well-researched, carefully thought out and beautifully presented project than three rushed pieces.

All projects should be returned to school no later than Monday 9th October. We will then arrange a time for parents to come in a view your finished work.

Project	Number of House Points Achievable
1) Research and present information about health and medicine in Victorian Times. You may use any media you choose including: Power point, models, information posters and written reports to present your information.	10
2) Make some simple Victorian recipes at home (e.g. Apple Charlottes, Custard Patties). Write out the recipes and take photos of your finished work. You could ask people at home to write a short review of your efforts or create your own Victorian recipe book.	10
3) Research and write a newspaper article about the London Match girls' strike of 1888.	12
4) Write and illustrate a journal about different aspects of life for working class Victorians. You could include: factories, coal mines, chimney sweeps, maids and much more.	15
5) Research a famous Victorian artist and recreate one of their pieces in your choice of media (e.g. pencil, water colour etc).	10
