Term 3 - Year 3 homework project options

Below are five options for homework projects for this term. Each project incorporates different skills and you should choose at least one of these to complete before the end of term. Each project has a number of house points attached to it; we have allocated the number of house points according to the level of difficulty/time needed for each project.

Although you may choose to complete more than one project we must stress that it is quality not quantity that counts; we would rather receive one well-researched, carefully thought out and beautifully presented project than three rushed pieces.

All projects should be returned to school by Friday 13th October 2017. We will then arrange a time for parents to come in to view your finished work in the last week of term.

Project	Number of House Points Achievable
1) Design your own mythical creature. Which animals' body parts could you include in your design? What personality will your creature have? Make your miniature creature using junk material, give it a fabulous name and write a short description of it.	15
2) Look at travel brochures and websites. Plan a family holiday to one of the Greek islands for at least 1 week. If money were no object, where would you go? What would you visit? Where would you stay? How much would it cost you?	15
3) Create a new sport for the Olympic Games. Write down the rules and be prepared to teach it to your friends.	10
4) Look carefully at the shape of the letters of the Greek alphabet. Write a secret message on a scroll or tablet for your class to decode.	10
5) Read about Narcissus, the boy who fell in love with his own reflection. What is the moral of the story? Write a letter to Narcissus telling him to change his ways.	10
