Term 1 - Year 2 homework project options

Below are five options for homework projects for this term. Each project incorporates different skills and you should choose at least one of these to complete before the end of term. Each project has a number of house points attached to it; we have allocated the number of house points according to the level of difficulty/time needed for each project.

Although you may choose to complete more than one project we must stress that it is quality not quantity that counts; we would rather receive one well-researched, carefully thought out and beautifully presented project than three rushed pieces.

All projects should be returned to school in the week beginning 16th October. We will then arrange a time for parents to come in to view your finished work in the last week of term.

Project	Number of House Points Achievable
1) Go on a bridge hunt with your grown-ups around the local area, taking photographs to show your class. What types of bridges have you seen? Draw a picture of one of the bridges that you have seen.	10
2) Make your own information book about castles, bridges or tunnels. What fascinating facts can you find out to amaze your teachers!	15
3) Design and make a 3D model of a famous structure from around the world, using junk materials found at home. Will you choose London Bridge, the Leaning Tower of Pisa or the Great Wall of China?	15 for a 3D model
4) Make a poster about a famous landmark. Where is it and why is it famous?	10
5) Make a detailed diagram of a castle, labelling interesting features, which may be found inside or outside the castle.	10
