


**Literacy:** Children will have the opportunity to research and create their own planet transferring this into a non-chronological report. Short, suspense stories will also be a focus using a range of writing techniques. Children will be creating their own imagery poetry using figurative language.

**Numeracy:** Children will be learning the bus stop method as well as multiplying and dividing numbers by 10/100/1000. In addition to this, they will know that angles are measured in degrees as well using their knowledge of angles to find missing ones.



**Music:** Children will be listening to a range of exciting Jazz compositions and incorporating instruments into this. They will also be taking part in some practical warm up activities to stand them in good stead for their overall performances.



**Science:** In Science, the children will be looking in detail at the shapes of planets and the movements of these around the sun. Also, they will be understanding why we have day and night and the movement of the moon around the Earth.

**PSHE:** Children will be looking at developing a healthy, safer lifestyle. With this, they will be able to recognise the different risks in different situations before deciding how to behave responsibly. This work will enable them to recognise risks and make informed decisions on how to behave responsibly.

# Stargazers

**History:** In History children will be focussing on Galileo Galilei, hailed as the 'father' of modern observational astronomy. They will find out about his life, work and in particular, his discovery of sun spots on the Sun.

**R.E:** In R.E the children we be looking in depth at a range of paintings depicting the Nativity scene. They will be comparing and contrasting these styles before creating their own unique scene with a given media.

**PE:** In indoor PE this term, the children will be taking part in the exciting unit of yoga. They will learn the basic breathing techniques and will understand how to use these in day-to-day life. For outdoor PE, the children will be completing the unit of 'Boxercise'. They will be putting their fitness to the test with a range of strenuous, physical exercises.

**French:** Children will be learning about the traditions of Christmas in France and associated festive vocabulary. They are also going to be revising days of the week, months of the year and times of the day. In addition to this, they will be recalling the numbers from 20-100 and consolidating 0-19.
