


Science -Evolution
Charles Darwin, Mary Anning and other relevant scientists will be our focus this term. We will create fact files about these important scientists and learn about their findings. Evolution will also be a focus as we learn about how and why animals and humans have adapted to their surroundings over time.

ICT - Programming
This term we will revisit programming using Scratch as our platform. We will learn how to write our own programs sharing the games with our peers. We will also focus on e-safety own online safety being a priority.

History - Victorians
This term we will be particularly looking at how children lived during the Victorian era. We will be learning about the industrial revolution and considering the contrast between the lives of rich and poor people.

Literacy
In literacy this term we will be covering the following genres: description, diary and poetry writing. The children will focus on aspects of grammar including expanded noun phrases, tense and word categories.



RE - How do Muslims show commitment to God?
In RE will be learning about the five pillars of Islam and the ways in which Muslims show their commitment to God through prayer, fasting and charitable donations.

Numeracy
In numeracy we will be learning the place value of numbers to 10,000,000 and refining methods of calculation. The children will learn to use and apply these skills in practical contexts. We will also be learning about number patterns including: sequences, prime numbers, factors and multiples.

DT
In DT we will be developing sewing skills to create traditional Victorian samplers. The children will learn to use different stitching techniques as well as how to begin and end a piece of needlework.

PE
Our new PE - Rising Stars Champions will be followed this term. Ball games are our outdoor PE with the children looking at the skills involved. Indoor PE is circuit training with a focus on how exercise affects our bodies.

SEAL/PSHEE - Economics and New Beginnings
The children will be learning about self-worth and target setting, moving on to a basic understanding of economics. In SEAL they will be thinking about new beginnings in different contexts.

Geography
In geography the children will be learning about the countries that make up the UK and investigating the changes that have occurred since the Victorian Era. They will also study the local area and how it has changed over time.
