

Science

Science will link with our topic work about the plague. The children will investigate what bacteria is, where most colonies form as well as how easily it can spread. They will learn about the life cycles of bacteria, fleas and rats and make comparisons between them.

ICT

During computing this term, the children will be using 'Scratch' to build their own game. This will include creating a character, backdrops and point system.

History

Our topic this term is 'Peasants, Princes and Pestilence'. The children will be learning what life was like in England during the plague, where it originated from and how it affected people physically.

Literacy

In Literacy the children will be learning about the life and works of William Shakespeare. They will study Romeo and Juliet looking at both modern day adaptations as well as attempting to understand Shakespearean terminology in the original play script. The children will then write their own version of this classic play.

RE

In R.E the children will develop their knowledge and understanding of Christian worship. They will learn the importance of prayer to Christians as well as beginning to understand the Holy Trinity. Moreover they will learn about the Christian rules and values, the ten commandments,

Numeracy

In Numeracy the children will be working on reasoning with measures, which will include work on perimeter and area of shapes. Following on from this, the children will be building on their understanding of fractions, focussing on improper fractions and mixed numbers.

French

This term in French the children are revising French food including fruit, months of the year, days of the week, sports and hobbies. The children will also investigate the difference between French and English eating habits.

PE

This term in indoor PE, the children will be focussing on their symmetrical and asymmetrical movements in gymnastics. They will then use these to create a sequence focussing on fluidity and control. In outdoor PE, the children will be working on their dance skills in 'step to the beat'. They will be performing moves to music which will focus on coordination and balance.

SEAL/PSHEE -

In this subject the children will be thinking about Citizenship, their rights and responsibilities both at home and at school. They will be learning the importance of laws and rules as well as looking at how religion can contribute towards society.

Outdoor Learning

During this unit the children will have the opportunity to design maps showing the spread of the plague using natural materials. They will create a London street scene creating medieval houses in the nature area.
