Term 2 - Year 3 homework project options

Below are five options for homework projects for this term. Each project incorporates different skills and you should choose at least one of these to complete before the end of term. Each project has a number of house points attached to it; we have allocated the number of house points according to the level of difficulty/time needed for each project.

Although you may choose to complete more than one project we must stress that it is quality not quantity that counts; we would rather receive one well-researched, carefully thought out and beautifully presented project than three rushed pieces.

All projects should be returned to school by Friday 8th December 2017 and **not before please**. We will then arrange a time for parents to come in to view your finished work in the last week of term.

Project	Number of House Points Achievable
1) Go on a magnetic treasure hunt in your house. How many magnetic objects can you find? What materials are they made from? Think creatively about how you could show us.	Up to 10 house points
2) Research some jobs done by robots. What jobs do you think they might do in the future? Talk to your parents - what jobs would they like a robot to do? Design your robot and explain what it would do.	Up to 15 house points
3) Design your perfect playground. What real or imaginary equipment would you include?	Up to 15 house points
4) Imagine you wake up and all the metal in the world has vanished. Write a story about your day. How would life be different without metal?	Up to 10 house points
5) Search the web for artwork made of metal. Make a scrapbook or collage of downloaded images. Explain which is your favourite piece and why.	Up to 10 house points
