

Science

The children will identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they get nutrition from what they eat. They will also find out that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Literacy

We will start the term by writing haiku poems about predators. Then, we will move onto conducting research so that we can write our own non-chronological reports about our favourite hunters.

Maths

In maths we will begin learning about different types of measuring, before using our knowledge to solve problems. Next we will be learning about fractions, what they are and finding fractions of amounts.

RE

We will be looking at miracles and questioning whether sacred texts have to be true to help people understand their religion.

ICT

We will be learning about the purposes of websites and how they can be used to present information. We will then have a go at presenting information that we have found out about our topic.

Geography

This term the children will be improving their map skills and fieldwork skills so that they can locate countries and continents where their favourite hunters can be found.

PE

Indoor PE this term will be 'groovy gymnastics'. This will take place on a **Friday**. Outdoor PE will focus on skipping for fitness and will take place on a **Wednesday**. Please ensure children have appropriate footwear and clothing for indoor and outdoor sessions.
