

History – World War Two

Getting into role, we will start our theme with an exciting 'Evacuee Day', where we will role play being sent to live in the country, far away from the bombing of cities. In addition to learning about life for evacuees, we will also study other aspects of WW11 including: key events of the war, the impact of the war on the local area and how life in Britain changed during wartime.

Literacy

In literacy, we will be creating calligram poems, writing journals in role as evacuees and producing persuasive leaflets to recruit wartime pilots for the Battle of Britain.

Numeracy

We will continue to work on calculation methods and alongside this will complete units on fractions and graphs. The children will learn to calculate with fractions, find equivalence and compare to decimals and percentages. They will read line graphs and construct pie charts.

PE

For indoor PE this term year 6 will have yoga with a qualified instructor. Outdoor PE will be 'Step to the Beat', and involves aerobic exercises.

ICT – Networking

This term the children will be learning how to take pictures effectively, how to download, edit and present these to the best effect. They will use a range of cameras and other digital equipment.

Geography – A study of cities in the UK and Europe

This term, we will be developing our map reading skills by identifying the countries within and outside of Europe that took part in WWII.

Science – Electricity.

This term, we will be learning about circuits and the different components that are included within them. We will be investigating the effects that adding and taking away these components can have on circuits and the reasons why.

RE – Learning from People of Faith and Religious Leaders

We will be looking at a selection of religious leaders and why people choose to follow a certain faith. We will then look at religious leaders from the time of WW11 and consider the roles they played.

SEAL/PSHE – Going for Goals and Healthy Lifestyle

The children will be learning about the difference between medicinal and illegal drugs, the negative effects of drugs and alcohol and how to keep themselves safe and healthy through sensible lifestyle choices.

DT/Art

In DT we will be developing construction skills including: designing, cutting and joining to create model air raid shelters. In Art we will be refining sketching skills, learning to use perspective and shading to add texture and depth to our art work.
