## Term 3 - Year 3 homework project options

Below are five options for homework projects for this term. Each project incorporates different skills and you should choose at least one of these to complete before the end of term. Each project has a number of house points attached to it; we have allocated the number of house points according to the level of difficulty/time needed for each project.

Although you may choose to complete more than one project we must stress that it is quality not quantity that counts; we would rather receive one well-researched, carefully thought out and beautifully presented project than three rushed pieces.

All projects should be returned to school by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2018 and not before please. We will then arrange a time for parents to come in to view your finished work in the last week of term.

Project	Number of House Points Achievable
1) Write a set of instructions for how to take care of your ultimate predator.	Up to 10
2) Make a set of 10 Top Trump cards about your favourite predators. Don't forget the headings need to be the same on all the cards.	Up to 15
3) Visit the local library or go online to find information about predators. Present the information in whichever format you choose as a short 5 minute presentation to the class.	Up to 15
4) Find the name of 10 predators and list them in order of how fast they can run. Compare this to human speed.	Up to 10
5) Make a collage of your favourite predator.	Up to 15
