Year 6 homework project options for term 2

Below are five options for homework projects for this term. Each project incorporates different skills and you should choose at least one of these to complete before the end of term. Each project has a number of house points attached to it; we have allocated the number of house points according to the level of difficulty/time needed for each project.

Although you may choose to complete more than one project we must stress that it is quality not quantity that counts; we would rather receive one well-researched, carefully thought out and beautifully presented project than three rushed pieces.

All projects should be returned to school no later than Monday 11th December.

Project	Number of House Points Achievable
1) Find out about Mexican flowers, trees and animals. Some are really different to the ones in the UK. Choose one flower or plant, one tree and one animal and write about these. Draw a detailed diagram of each.	10
2) Find out more about Mayan hieroglyphs and symbols. Write a message using these.	10
3) Plan an imaginary trip or holiday to Mexico. Look at holiday brochures or research online. How many ways are there to get there? How long would it take? How much would it cost? Make an itinerary for your trip showing what you would like to see and do while you are there.	15
4) Make a model of a Mayan village. Research how this would be set out (we will cover this in class) and make either a 3D model or a 2D detailed plan.	12
5) Create a quiz about Mexico including facts and information. You should have at least 15 questions.	10
