Literacy (Specific Area)-

Creative Development (Specific Area)

This term we will be developing our skills in design and technology, creating our own emergency vehicles out of boxes and other recycled materials. Mathematics (Specific Area)-

This term we will be learning how to...

- Count objects and recognise the total number.
- Identify numerals 1-5
- Name simple 2D shapes
- Compare sizes of things in terms of length, weight and capacity

Physical Development (Prime Area)-

This term we will be learning how to...

- Use one handed tools accurately
- Move over equipment in different ways, testing out our balance skills
- Run around a space negotiating different obstacles

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (Prime Area) -

We will continue to build relationships within the Nursery. We will be learning how to ask for help and how to let others know when we need something. We will be learning about helping each other.
