In line with new safeguarding recommendations I am writing to advise/remind you about arrangements for pupils at the end of the day including after school clubs.

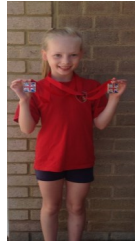
Please utilise the paths when walking around the front of the school. Thank you.

## Summer Holiday Club

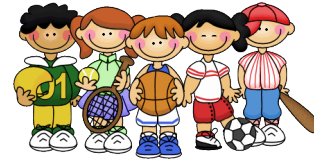
