RE Curriculum

There will be a change in provision for RE this year due to the new Lincolnshire Syllabus being introduced. As a maintained school we have to follow this. For the foreseeable future in Key Stage 1 we will study Christianity and Islam rather than Christianity, Judaism and Hinduism which we have done to date. In KS2 we will study Christianity, Islam and Hinduism. There is some capacity to look at other areas and we are able to pick one other unit in each Key Stage.

Reading Rewards

This year, we are changing the way that children will be rewarded for their reading in KS2. The children will still receive certificates for reading 28 times, but will no longer receive vouchers in celebration assembly at the end of each big term.

The children's reading books are aligned with our Accelerated Reader system. The children will be awarded points depending on the books they have read and will also complete an online quiz. At the end of each term, the child in each class who has gathered the most points will receive a prize. The class in each Key Stage who have completed the most quizzes (achieving a score of 80% or more) will

receive an extended break time. Any individuals who score 100% in all of their quizzes taken over the term, will join a special '100% Club' and receive a prize at the end of the term.
